Changes to the Ontario Lung Screening Program (OLSP): Supporting Patients at High Risk of Lung Cancer

In March 2025, the <u>Ontario Lung Screening Program (OLSP)</u> expanded to include additional hospital locations across the province. The program also changed the referral age criteria to **people ages 55 and older.** At age 80, people are exited from the program; however, they can continue to screen if appropriate.

OLSP Referral Inclusion Criteria:

If you are referring someone age 55 to 80, they must:

- Have a smoking history of any amount of cigarettes* daily for 20 years, and
- Have Ontario Health Insurance Plan (OHIP) coverage

Anyone age 80 or older requires a new referral every year.

If you are referring someone age 81 or older, they must:

- Have a smoking history of any amount of cigarettes* daily for 20 years
- Have Ontario Health Insurance Plan (OHIP) coverage
- Have discussed risk and benefits of lung screening with you
- Be well enough to undergo and recover from lung cancer treatment
- Have a lifespan (over 5 years) to benefit from treatment

*People who have been exposed to second-hand smoke or used other kinds of tobacco, such as cigars, pipe tobacco, chewing tobacco or e-cigarettes, are **not eligible** for lung cancer screening through the OLSP at this time.

Not everyone who meets the referral inclusion criteria will be eligible for lung cancer screening in the OLSP. For more information click <u>here</u>.

How to Refer Patients at High Risk of Getting Lung Cancer to the OLSP:

- Complete the OLSP referral form.
- Fax the completed referral form directly to the OLSP hospital location.
